Our Mother Foundress BI.AnneMarie Javouhey started this work in 1807 and she gave a great importance to the education of students. Even though education is the prime mission of our congregation, due importance is given to all the charitable works like, looking after the mentally deranged people, HIV patients, abandoned children, old people and many other, which is the need of the hour.

The Sisters of St.Joseph of Cluny aims at inculcating a sound, value based human education and formation for the total development of the whole person, making the student a well integrated person in all aspects, to build up a just, social order. To fulfill this vision here we have a band of 8 dedicated staff and 6 non-teaching staff for classes K.G to STD VII. This school offers CBSE curriculum, well integrated with the best practices of Indian Education system. Our school launched on 5th June 2017 with 22 students from LKG to STD I. This academic year we have classes from KG to STD VII with 148 students.

After the pandemic lockdown we reopened the school on 1st November 2021. We welcomed our students and teachers with at most care and protection. Sanitizers and face masks were compulsory.



We begin our day with morning assembly and prayer. Different classes take turn to conduct the assembly with various themes .During the assembly they learn proverbs, new vocabulary, and different types of action songs in order to improve their English language. We insist upon spoken English in the campus. Value education classes are conducted every day.

In the school students are divided into 4 houses in order to have a better competitive spirit in their activities. Four houses are named after the great personalities like Darwin, Aristotle, William Wordsworth and Newton. It helps the students have healthy competition in order to explore and exhibit their talents.

The various national and religious celebrations instill in the students patriotism as well as moral values in their lives. We celebrated festivals like Onam, Teacher's Day, Children's Day, Christmas, etc.

Competitions were held on various occasions and prizes and shield were distributed to the winners. Our children bagged prizes in SIP Arithmetic genius All India Online competition 2021.



We helped the poor children of our school by giving them fee concession - Rs.1,000,00/-during this academic year.

I am happy to inform you that next academic year we will have up to STD VIII and by God's grace we hope to grow higher and higher.
